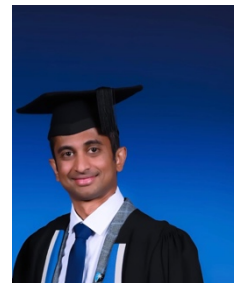

4. WORK EXPERIENCE

1. Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist (ROG) – German Sri Lanka Friendship Hospital Galle, Sri Lanka (2023 December to 2025)

I worked as the Resident Obstetrician and Gynaecologist in The German Sri Lanka Friendship Hospital Galle, which is the largest maternity hospital in the Southern Province, Sri Lanka. The hospital caters about 10000 deliveries per annum with 4 units including a university Obstetrics and Gynaecology unit. Average number of major surgeries is about 30 per week including gynaecological Oncology. I am involved in all Obstetrics and Gynaecology work including teaching Medical Students and Post Graduate trainees.

The hospital has a separate Urogynaecology unit and I am keen on gaining experience to enhance my clinical skills in urogynaecology to use this service to the maximum benefit of Sri Lankan women.

2. Consultant Obstetrician and Gynaecologist – Base hospital Dambadeniya, Sri Lanka (2022 December to 2023 December)

Base hospital Dambadeniya cater about 1600 deliveries per annum and I was in charge of the unit with six medical officers. About 40 major gynaecological surgeries per month were done both open and minimal access. One antenatal clinic and one Gynaecological clinic was carried out in a weekly basis. I carried out all the responsibilities of Obstetrics and Gynaecology in the Hospital.

3. Trust Doctor Level 2 in Obstetrics and Gynaecology – Russells Hall Hospital, Dudley, United Kingdom (January 2021 to December 2022)

Worked in the middle grade Rota under the supervision of 14 consultants in the unit. Total number of deliveries were about 4300 per annum. I have taken active participation in managing complex obstetric patients and participated in specialized clinics including diabetic antenatal clinics.

I have worked in general gynaecology clinics and also in endometriosis and urogynaecology clinics which were held on a weekly basis. I have taken part in assisting major gynaecological surgeries and also assisted endometriosis surgeries during the training period.

CSHW is one of the leading tertiary care hospitals for women in Sri Lanka with 300 obstetric beds, 94 gynaecology beds and 34 labour beds. There were 5 trainers and 10 training registrars. The total number of deliveries were around 15000 per annum in all five units.

During the third year of training I was able to go through short clinical appointments in Gynaecological Oncology, Urology and neonatal care in different specialized units.

I gained experience on continence surgeries like Burch colpo-suspension, TOT and prolapse surgeries during my training period.
