

Faculty of Medicine - University of Ruhuna



A unique medical school in a beautiful, historical city, ranked 2nd in the country

The Faculty of Medicine, University Of Ruhuna was established in Galle, in July 1980 as the 3rd medical faculty in the country. It's one of the most spacious medical faculties in Sri Lanka. The Faculty provides academic, research and service functions through its 14 academic departments and 3 units that are recognized by the University Grants Commission. There are 02 teaching hospitals affiliated to the faculty.

The Teaching Hospital at Karapitiya is the largest tertiary care hospital in the Southern province and the third-largest hospital in the Island. At present, it is equipped with over 1900 beds and there are 128 consultants attached to the hospital. It is situated just across the road from the Medical Faculty. The Medical, Surgical, Paediatrics, Psychiatry Units and numerous finer speciality Units are functioning in this hospital.

The academic Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology is situated in the premises of Teaching hospital Mahamodara which is the only Maternity Teaching hospital in Southern Province, with a 395 bed capacity currently located 5 km away from the faculty and soon will be relocated in a new premises closer to the faculty. The number of deliveries carried out in this hospital accounts for around 10,000 per annum and is the second highest number in the country.

Bope - Poddala is the community training area with a population density of 1678/km2 which is affiliated to the medical faculty for field training.

The Elective Programme for overseas medical students

Faculty of Medicine, University of Ruhuna is conducting the elective programme for last 15 years with high quality short term training for international medical undergraduates.

There is a possibility of conducting undergraduate and postgraduate research/audit in Sri Lanka following ethical and administrative clearance.

Applications should be made on the prescribed form which can be downloaded online, together with the other requirements mentioned in the website.

Visa processing-

The visa application process is straightforward online and be extended according to the need.

Maximum duration of stay upto 16 weeks

Transport facilities -

The Southern Expressway with luxury buses at frequent intervals allows comfortable and fast travel between Colombo and Galle and also directly between the airport and Galle city. Further there's an island wide public transport system facilitating safe travel to anywhere in the country including the railway system.

Accommodation will not be provided by the faculty but would be available in the vicinity of the hospital.

Food -


A number of outlets including the faculty cafeteria with both local and international cuisine are available close by with meals at reasonable prices.
