AS A MILITARY OFFICER AND A MILITARY ACADEMIC

- Joined Sri Lanka Army Volunteer Force as a Probationary Officer and Confirmed as a Captain in Sri Lanka Army Medical Corps(Volunteer) on 27.12.1990. Currently I am a full Colonel. I have served as the Medical Course Coordinator of General Sir John Kotelawala defence University. I played a major role in the establishment of the new medical faculty along with other staff from Faculty of Medicine, University of Ruhuna overcoming many obstacles.
- During the years I have served in many operational areas and seen action many times.
 I am the only volunteer officer to command Military Hospital, Palaly when I also overlooked the command of 1 Medical Corps Troops in Jaffna Peninsula. I have participated in official tours representing Sri Lankan Defense establishment in India, Bangladesh, Pakistan and China.
- I volunteered to serve our troops besieged in Jaffna Peninsula as the only Surgeon in the difficult days of year 2000. As the only surgeon in Jaffna I carried out my functions to entire satisfaction of my superiors saving hundreds of lives under most difficult conditions including continuous enemy bombardment. <u>I was awarded a Gallantry award RANA SURA PADDAKKAMA (RSP) by H.E the president of Sri Lanka for this action thus became the only Surgeon in Sri Lankan Armed Forces to earn such distinction in it's entire history of <u>125 years.</u>

- I came **first in the Second in Command Course** at Combat Training School in Ampara, in 2000 obtaining prizes for **best infantry tactician** and the **best tactical firer**. I was recommended to command a volunteer infantry battalion however my request for such was turned down.
- I was selected as the longest serving professional in the Sri Lanka Army Volunteer force to participate in a campaign to reorganize and increase Sri Lanka Army Volunteer Professional Reserve. This included news paper and television interviews.
