

Guidelines for Elective students programme

- Accept only the students who are fully vaccinated with Covid 19 vaccine
- On arrival to the Faculty – Students should have
 - negative PCR test within 5 days
 - or if students come more than 5 days of PCR test result further evaluation of RAT is needed. This should be arranged by the students by them from the registered private hospitals.
- Students should sent following documents to the Faculty prior to their arrival
 - PCR test result
 - Contact details & accommodation details in Sri Lanka
 - Health insurance certificate including Covid 19 cover
 - Payment receipts
- Students should strictly follow health advices during their training period.
 - Wearing face Masks
 - Hand washing & sanitizing
 - keeping the distance of 1 M
 - avoid attending high risk areas (eg. Patient's nebulizing areas/ positive pressure ventilation areas / patients resuscitation areas)
- Students should adhere to any additional health advices provided by the local authorities.
- Students should be aware that current health guidelines could be changed time to time and they should adhere with updated guidelines.
- Dress code – students should wear scrub (Pijama) , name tag mentioning name & as “elective student “ This should be responsibility of the each students to keep ready in advance to use at the commencement of the training.
- Preferably students should complete their compulsory training at a stretch and it is advisable them to stay in the same accommodation without travelling to other part of the country until they finish their elective training.
- Students are not allowed to take leave except if they are sick during the training period.
- Students are not allowed to enjoy with food & drinks as groups within the hospital premises
- Students with protected exposure with a Covid positive patient considered as low risk exposure. However students with unprotected exposure should be informed to the relevant Head of the department for further risk assessment. The students with suspected symptoms with Covid 19 should inform the Head of the department for appropriate actions.

 - Obst & Gynae – 8
 - Paediatrics - 8
 - Psychiatry – 3
 - Surgery 8
 - Community Medicine 12
 - Anaesthesia - 2

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
