

The Structure of the Degree and Management

Structure of the course

The Pre-clinical course is of five terms at the end of which students sit the 2nd MBBS examination in Anatomy, Biochemistry and Physiology. This examination is held twice a year. A student may be referred in one or two of these subjects but he/she shall, in all, be allowed only four attempts at this examination. There shall be no "grace" chances.

A student shall complete his Final Examination within 10 years from the starting date of the MBBS course as a student of the Faculty of Medicine. All periods of exemption granted by the Senate are excluded when computing this ten (10) years after the starting date of the MBBS course as a student of the Faculty of Medicine. The Final MBBS examination is held twice a year.

Faculty of Medicine offers its degree programme without any gender discrimination in teaching, learning and assessments.
